Funeral services were conducted at Neal Funeral Home, Lawrenceburg, Tennessee, May 15, 2017, with Phillip Jaco officiating.

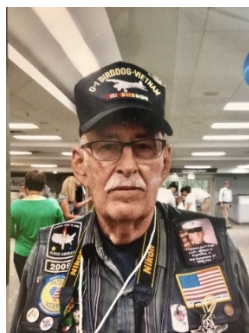
