# From the Cookbook

Yield: 4 servings  
Level: Easy  
Total Time: 1 hr

## Cheesy Broccoli Chicken Foil Packs

### Ingredients

- 1 package Stuffing mix; chicken flavor
- 1 1/4 cups Water
- 4 Boneless skinless chicken breast halves
- 4 cups Broccoli Florets
- 1 cups Shredded cheddar cheese
- 4 slices COOKED bacon; crumbled
- 4 tbsp Ranch dressing divided
- Oven to 400°

### Directions:

- Spray 4 large sheets of heavy-duty foil with oil.
- Combine stuffing mix and water.
- Spoon 1/4 of the stuffing mixture onto the center of each foil sheet.
- Top stuffing with a 6oz. chicken breast half.
- Top chicken with 1 cup broccoli.
- Sprinkle with 1/4 of the cheese and 1 slice of your already prepared bacon, crumbled.
- Drizzle each with 1 tbsp. ranch dressing
- Bring up foil sides and fold to seal, leaving room for heat circulation inside
- Place packets on a cookie sheet and bake 35-40 mins (depends on the size of your chicken breasts)
- Remove packets and let stand 5 mins
- Cut sits in foil for steam to escape before opening. ENJOY!!!
