It is not easy to do a newsletter when you were not at the camping. If anyone wants to help out and do the newsletters some of the time, that would be great. I would even share my salary. LOL




And my question is WHAT did Janet get ?

The Chosen Winner




Good looking group

Breakfast Casserole

1 lb. breakfast sausage

1 onion, diced

3 cups frozen shredded hash brown potatoes

1 (16 oz) container

¼ cup butter, melted

cottage cheese

12 oz mild Cheddar cheese, shredded

6 jumbo eggs

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Cook sausage in large, deep skillet over med-high heat until browned, drain and crumble , set aside.

Lightly grease 9X13 inch baking dish. In the prepared dish, stir together the shredded potatoes and butter. Line the bottom and sides of the baking dish with the mixture.

In a bowl, mix together sausage, Cheddar cheese, onion, cottage cheese and eggs. Pour over the potato mixture.

Bake 1 hour, or until the casserole reaches a safe internal temperature of 160 degrees as measured with a food thermometer. Let cool for 5 minutes before serving. Refrigerate any leftovers.
