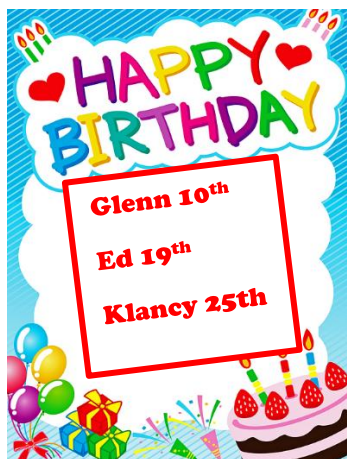




JANUARY 2021 NEWSLETTER
